

Statement of Tuition Assurance

- 1. The Tuition Protection Service (TPS) is an initiative of the Australian Government to assist international students and eligible domestic students accessing FEE-HELP or a HECS-HELP (HELP) loan, whose education providers are unable to fully deliver their course of study.
- 2. The Australian School of Accounting Pty Ltd [Trading as Australian School of Accounting (ASA)] is registered on the Commonwealth Register of Institutions and Courses for Overseas Students (CRICOS) and has approval to deliver its courses to international students as well as to domestic students.
- 3. The TPS ensures that international students and eligible domestic students are able to either:
 - Complete their studies in another course or with another education provider
 - Or receive a refund of their unspent tuition fees.
- 4. In the unlikely event that ASA cannot deliver the course a student has paid for and has been unable to find a suitable alternative course for the student, the TPS will help the student find another course with minimal disruption to their studies. If a suitable alternative course is not found, the TPS will refund the tuition fees that have been paid, for the part of the course they have not yet received.
